## NIHAN Geriatrics Grand Rounds: Caring for Older Adults Through Telehealth

Telehealth helps increase healthcare value and affordability. It is a convenient and flexible option for all, including geriatric patients facing mobility limitations, transportation issues, and more. Participants of the Nevada Interprofessional Healthy Aging Network (NIHAN) Geriatrics Grand Rounds (GGRs) will learn to implement the 4Ms Framework of care via telehealth.



The NIHAN GGR program is free provider training, in partnership with **Comagine Health**. The providers can register for up to six training courses—each comprised of a pre-recorded didactic session and a live webinar. **Participants can earn up to 12 CME credits**:

- 1 credit for each 1-hour didactic session
- 1 credit for each 1-hour live webinar
